

Your 46er Contributions at Work -- 2018 Season: [9-30-2018]

This past calendar year the 46er Board voted to contribute **\$ 56,387** to various agencies, individuals, and programs. This was financed by **member donations** of **\$60,545**. Those of you who send a few extra dollars with your regular dues make funding these programs possible. Thanks to your generosity the Executive Board was able to fund the following projects:

- \$ 6,000 For ADK's Pro Trail crew to complete a pre-season trail sweep and blowdown removal.
- \$ 6,000 Paid for a Wildlife Conservation Bear Steward at the Upper Works Trailhead to educate campers and hand out bear canisters.
- \$ 20,000 For Big Slide trailwork by ADK Pro Crew.
- \$ 15,000 For the Summit Steward Program budget.
- \$ 640 To the 507 Fund to create an endowment for the Summit Steward Program.
- \$ 6,647 For approved Lean2 Rescue expenses.
- \$ 1,400 Paid four camperships for area children to attend DEC Conservation Camps.
- \$ 500 Wilderness First Aid Tuition Reimbursement Program to 7 individuals.
- \$ 200 The Nature Conservancy and Protect the Adirondacks.
